
EWRRC 2021/22 Strategic Planning Report

In-Person Meeting in April 2022

• Most people who attended expect most of the topics/projects could be done in one year.

- Mobile grocery store


Foothills Food Bank is working on these processes/ideas and the EWRRC participates in the Foothills Community Food Partnership to address this work.

- Beautification
 - Quarterly large trash picks up
 - Community garbage cans
 - Donate to my neighbors who need help with garbage service
 - Incentive/stipend for community Adopt a Block
- Safety
 - Walking trail to stores & library
 - Crosswalk
- Youth & Family Services
 - Teen activities: Skatepark
 - Childcare
 - Incentivized Parenting Classes
 - Nature-based free kids' program (After school/Summer)


Online & Mailed Paper Survey to all of East Whatcom

(Total of 52 responses)


- Most common answers in "other" were: food access and community recreation spaces and safety"
- The top choices were Community Recreation Spaces, Food Access, and Safety
- People requested a dog park and exercise classes




• As was true with the in-person meeting, most people expect to see the change in 1-2 years.



 Top choices for funding were: Food Access and Community Recreation Spaces echoing what was learned at the last EWRRC Strategic Planning in 2015; Healthcare and Safety were neck and neck for funding.

• Comments and Feedback:

Critical

- It would be nice to have more community centered events at the EWRRC itself.
- I think that a number of beautification projects could be done on a volunteer/donation basis in public spaces if well coordinated.
- There is no point in most of your community options because you hold your events such as mental health and healthcare DURING WORKING HOURS. I don't know if you live on this planet but stuff is hitting the fan and people can't miss work with this inflation.
- We need more sheriff deputies up here, as well as animal control. It has gotten way out of control in regards to animals on the loose, people neglecting their animals, and people not getting their pets spayed or neutered when there are free programs available for this.
- I would like the EWRRC to have a secure regulation mailbox drop so we don't have to drive to Maple Falls or Deming. It is not safe in my area to leave outgoing mail in my mailbox for pick up.

- You are doing great work, but I think the choices here could have been more specific or each contained examples like were given for community beautification.

Planners After Action Notes:

- Recommend outreach three months prior next strategic planning through flyers, social media, reader boards, pop-ups and partners.
- Encourage historical review and celebrations be posted on the webpage and in the building six months in advance- this is helpful for folks who were not able to participate in the past and to set the stage.
- Aim for next strategic planning in early 2025 to be completed by 2026.
- Continue with surveys: mailed, online, over the phone, and in person options in addition to a facilitated meeting onsite.
