First what is Ideal Option?

Ideal Option is an outpatient addiction medicine clinic in Bellingham, WA. Who provides evidence-based treatment for addiction to opioids like fentanyl, heroin, and oxycodone, and stimulants like methamphetamine and cocaine. They also provide medication-assisted treatment for alcohol withdrawal and relapse prevention.

Employees of Ideal Options met with our staff to discuss their services as well as discussed having their peer counselor come to our Community Monthly Events to do a meet and greet with the residents, from there we will continue to grow the partnership and wrap around services and hope to have their peer counselor provide a monthly drop in service for our residents.
